Your abstract needs to be:

- written in English
- 200 to 300 words
- submitted via e-mail as a Microsoft Word document

Your final article needs to be:

- written in, or have been translated into, English
- 1000-3000 words

# THE BOOK ISSUE

TXT needs your thoughts on an exciting issue: the surprising persistence of the paper book. We are living in the digital age, so why has paper not been killed yet, along with the video tape and the music cd? What symbolic value does the book possess that makes it surprisingly resilient in the face of its proclaimed mortality? And how has this value changed from the book's conception until now?

International journal TXT is the official annual of Book and Digital Media Studies at Leiden University. This graduate programme scrutinises textual media through time and space, trying to put a finger on how they affect our thinking and our culture.

In 2018, TXT wants to place the paper book in the limelight and open up interdisciplinary debate on how it serves and has served society as more than the sum of its pages.
